HISTORY:

Collaborative Partnership between caring organizations (government, non-profit, faith-based, etc) to connect ex-offenders to the services that they need after release.

MISSION:

The mission of UCRNSP is to provide support and opportunities for offenders re-entering society through a collaborative effort, to safely reintegrate and reunite families.

VISION:

Promote public safety by reducing the threat of harm to persons and their property by released offenders in the communities to which those offenders return.

Increase success rates of offenders who transition from prison by fostering effective risk management and treatment programming, offender accountability, and community and victim participation to reduce recidivism rates.

Assure a systemic approach to reentry in Tennessee so that all those involved in offender reentry are working toward the same vision, mission and goals.

OUTREACH:

Due to the mission of UCRNSP to provide support and opportunities for offenders re-entering society; the collaborative partners have come together to form a continuum of systematic care to help with the successful integration back to the community.

*The UCRNSP provides services to ex-offenders transitioning to the Knoxville Community who MAY OR MAY NOT under the supervision of the Board of Probation & Parole.
